ProCapital, a financial service provider for online brokers, uses GMC PrintNet™ solution to turn every stock market transaction notification (a legal document sent to private investors after every order placed) into a personalised marketing tool.

ProCapital, the creator and operator of a software platform for online brokerage financial services, is established in France and Belgium. Used by asset management firms and banks, its solution registers, processes and monitors market orders placed by their private investor clients. In accordance with financial market regulations, asset management firms and online brokers are required to issue transaction notifications after every order placed. These are then sent to their clients by mail.

Quality & Broad Range of Services are Competitive Advantage

"For asset management firms, these mailings provide a real opportunity for communication with their clients," explains Anthony Ginepro, Manager of Electronic Publishing at ProCapital. On an increasingly competitive market, online brokers and asset management firms are also looking to differentiate themselves through the quality of the printed documents they send their clients. This involves presentation as well as the content and relevance of information. Consequently, as a global service provider, ProCapital has enhanced its publishing services. It now offers its customers all the responsiveness they are entitled to expect regarding the personalisation of the documents they receive.

Before adopting GMC PrintNet, ProCapital was bound to an outsourced publishing solution. Integrating update requests for document templates such as transaction notifications sometimes took several days. In numerous cases, these modifications required a partial or complete rewrite of the application code for managing document composition, even when all that was required was the addition of a data field to an existing document. With this approach, every customer had to be treated as a separate case, meaning that the developments made could neither be shared nor re-used and were therefore more costly. To consolidate its position on the market, ProCapital wanted to find a solution that would enable it to cut the cost of managing its publishing services and improve responsiveness, while offering new services with higher added value.

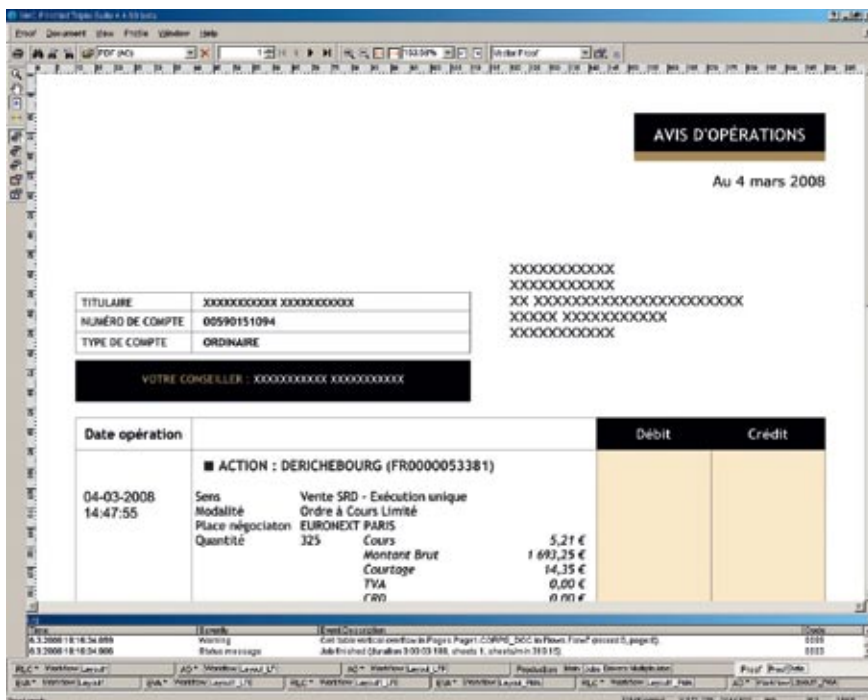
Single Source, Global Solution Needed

"To achieve this we needed to bring our publishing activities back in-house," continues Anthony Ginepro. Once the decision was made, ProCapital began looking for a global solution to manage its publishing system that would meet its criteria. The chosen solution needed to significantly reduce the time and cost of incorporating modifications requested by customers. The aim was also to simplify the integration of new data and to be able to offer new document personalisation services. This allows asset management customers to promote new financial products to particular investors, or add the name of the client's designated banking adviser to the transaction notification.

GMC's PrintNet suite met all of ProCapital's requirements, allowing it to implement simple and reusable procedures for updating graphics or including data in transaction notifications and management documents produced for asset management firms and online brokers. With PrintNet, the time taken to incorporate a modification request is reduced to under 48 hours. "One of the reasons for this increase in responsiveness is that with PrintNet you can make modifications by simply adjusting the settings, and then immediately display an exact view of the result," says Anthony Ginepro. This lets asset management firms and online brokers take full advantage of the space in letters that they are legally obliged to send their clients. Importantly, this means they can respond to developments in the market or changes to regulations and immediately give their clients the data they might need, such as tax information relating to the management of a share savings plan.

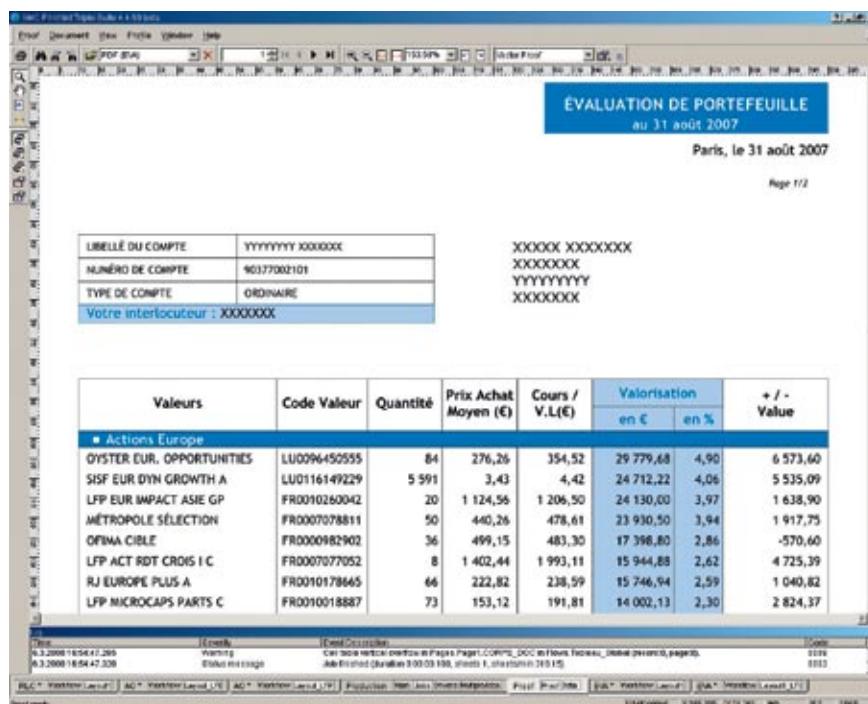

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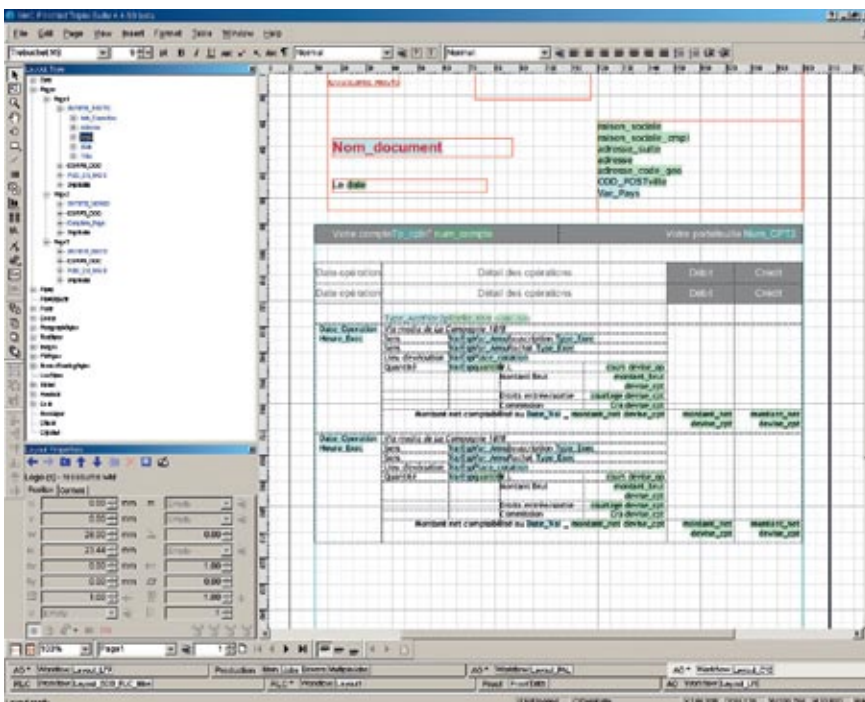
